INDEPENDENCE DAY CELEBRATIONS AT MPT

Dr. E. Ramesh Kumar, IAS Chairman, MPT, unfurled the national flag, took the salute and inspected the parade at the Independence Day celebrations in port. He addressed an impressive gathering of Trustees of the Board, Dy. It was the culmination of the supreme sacrifices and the undeterred valour and immolation of our might and most revered freedom fighters, drawn from across the length and breadth of the country, irrespective of their social and economic status. They have shed their sweat and blood only to see Mother India – free, sovereign plural and egalitarian and was absolute".

Recalling the supreme sacrifices of the Father of the Nation Mahatma Gandhi, Dr. Ramesh Kumar showered profuse praises saying “Mahatma Gandhi is unmatched and unparallel in the annals of the history of any nation. He is the guiding light of our successful effort to liberate our nation, whose 150th birth anniversary we will be celebrating on 2nd October”.

“Looking back on the last 72 years of Independence, it is widely believed from the days when the concept of zero first appeared in India around A.D. 458. In 628, a Hindu astronomer and mathematician named Brahmagupta developed a symbol for zero – a dot underneath numbers, till the latest space marvel, of the launch of Chandrayan-2 on 22nd July 2019, India has made progress in every field, be it education or sports or its military prowess or the space programmes” said Dr. Ramesh Kumar.

The Chairman highlighted the role of the women and youth in the task of nation building and the creativity, hard work and dynamism of millions of Indians. The Chairman laid emphasis on the strides of progress made on the political front and the abrogation of Article 370 which will bring immense benefits to the regions of Jammu and Kashmir and Ladakh. The Chairman also highlighted the steps initiated by the Port Management on the environment protection. He complimented the untiring efforts and sacrifices of the port family and expressed confidence that the port will soon be at its best.

The celebrations ended with a pageantry of colourful cultural display, and singing of patriotic songs by the students of the Primary, Secondary and Higher Secondary schools run by the MPT Education Society.



SWACHHTA PAKHWADA OBSERVANCE IN MPT

MPT observed Swachhta Pakhwada in a befitting manner by organising various events and programs. The Swachhta Pakhwada was inaugurated at the hands of the Chairman Dr. E. Ramesh Kumar, IAS on 16-09-2019. Under the inspiration and guidance of the Chairman Dr. E. Ramesh Kumar IAS, the Nodal Officer for Swachha Bharat Abhiyan, Shri Guruling Gani, Dy. - * Mormugao Port Trust in coordination with Lions Club of Mormugao organised a 2 hour workshop on **HOME WASTE MANAGEMENT** and re-cycling of household wastes on 23/09/2019 at Mormugao Port

Institute. Dy. Chairman/ MPT Shri G.P. Rai, was the Chief Guest for the workshop. Programme was arranged on the theme of 'Swachhta Hi Sewa'. Mr. Clinton Vaz, of Recycle Waste Management Services, was the resource person who shared valuable information about Home Waste Management and demonstrated the process of composting.

* Port employees undertook an awareness drive in the local markets highlighting the need to discard plastic bags and plastics from daily use. The port distributed free cloth bags to the citizens in the fruit and vegetable markets.

*Cleanliness drives were held in the offices, dock areas, CISF residential Unit, in the port residential colonies, and the neighbourhood of Sada village.

*Street plays were staged in the town to bring about an awareness. School students also presented skits highlighting the need to protect the environment and discard plastics from daily use. The Port run Deep Vihar High school students also held a rally in the residential areas bringing about an awareness on the cleanliness and discard of plastics from daily use. The local councillors supported the Port initiative during the drives.

* Various competitions were organised for the students of schools and educational institutions. Similarly skit and 'Wealth out of wastes' competitions were organised for the officers and staff of MPT, which received an overwhelming response.



HON'BLE SHIPPING MINISTER VISITS MPT

Shri Mansukh Mandaviya, Hon'ble Minister of State for Shipping (Independent Charge), Chemical & Fertilisers, accompanied by Shri Anilkumar Radadiya, Additional PS to Hon'ble Minister, visited MPT on 26-09-2019. He was received at the Dabolim Airport by Dr. E. Ramesh Kumar IAS, Chairman, along with Dy. Chairman and Secretary. Shri Mauvin Godinho, Minister for Transport, Protocol & Panchayat Raj, Govt. of Goa, was also present at the airport to receive the Hon'ble Minister.

The Hon'ble Minister later along with the Chairman, Dy. Chairman Secretary and Traffic Manager visited the operational areas in the port as well as South West Port Terminal, Adani Mormugao Port Terminal, and the cruise berth terminal. Chairman, Dr. E. The new Loco was inaugurated at the hands of Shri Guruprasad Rai, Dy. Chairman, MPT on 31/07/2019, in the presence of the Port officers and officials of M/s. RITES.

Unresolved Grievances Bothering You?

You may seek help of Directorate of Public Grievances (DPG) in resolution of grievances relating to Ministries/Departments and Organisations under its purview. In last few years, nearly ninety percent of the grievances taken up by the Directorate have been resolved favourably.

Please read carefully the conditions listed below before lodging your grievance:

- You should have exhausted the Departmental remedies for individual grievances.
- Your grievance should not relate to service matter (other than payment of terminal benefits like gratuity, GPF etc.), a case disposed of at the level of Minister of the concerned Department, commercial contract, a sub-judice case, a case where quasi-judicial procedures and appellate mechanisms are prescribed for decision making, RTI matter, Religious matter.
- Suggestion of any sort will not be treated as grievance.

- आपकी शिकायत सेवा मामले (ग्रेजुएट, जीपीएफ इत्यादि जैसे सेवागत कितनामों के चुनौती के अन्तर्गत), संबंधित विभाग के मंत्री के स्तर पर निपटारा पर मामला, वाणिज्यिक अनुबंध, व्यावसायिक मामले, ऐसे मामले जहाँ निर्णय लेने के लिए अर्द्धन्यायिक प्रणाली और अपीलीय प्रक्रियाएँ निर्धारित की गई हैं, आरटीआई मामले, धार्मिक मामले से संबंधित न हो।
